

1.9. TONE (CHAKHON KAKUU-KANAH)

Lianglad hai ‘Tonal Language’ ye. Samtap dinsai aliu lad ga Tone pazat sum bamme, kuubo, n-gangbo khatdi nahbo. Tone tiubo ra chakhon kuubo nahbo sai sujiu chaladkeng (Spelling nchambo) ramba kalibo tuwe. Aliu ariak raobo ga debo khon niu kuubo lo, desi nahbo lo tiu sitam pad ra macha khaibo phui ncham khe.

Chakhon kakuubo (high Tone) ga kanamthubo giak (Letter or Symbol) si ‘doubling’ khe. N-gangbo khon (Mid Tone) ra wadi khai san mak di suiyé. Chakhon kanahbo (Low Tone) ga kanamthubo giak sai ‘h’ khai khe chiu chap khaiye. Pahang ga Example kasia pikhai bamme.
